



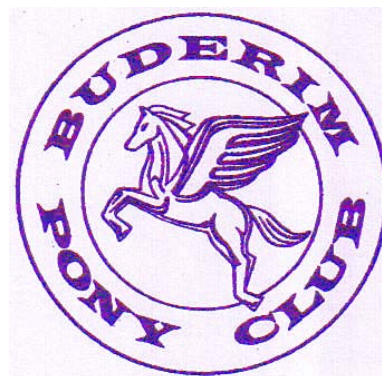

## Rules and Information

### Acceptance

- The rules of this competition will be the current PCAQ rules.
- PCAQ membership cards must be produced on the day.
- **Non PCAQ members must sign the attached PCAQ Participant’s Agreement or entries will not be accepted.**
- A horse is not to be ridden by more than one rider, nor ridden in more than one class.
- Stallions are **not** eligible to enter.
- No alcohol permitted to be consumed on the grounds whilst event is in progress.
- The organising committee reserves the right to split / combine groups as necessary.

### Dress

- School polo shirt must be worn.
- Approved riding boots must be worn.
- Top boots or gaiters can be worn but no chaps.
- A correctly fitting helmet must be worn - Equestrian type (AS/NZ 3838, EN 1384 or ASTMF 1163 or better).
- Only approved Pony Club gear to be used – refer PCAQ Handbook.

### Protests

- **Judge’s decision is final**
- Objections or disputes to be made to the official Technical Delegate, with a deposit of \$50, no later than half an hour after the disputed incident, or half an hour after the start of the competition for a disputed qualification of a horse or competitor. The deposit will be returned if the objection is upheld, or there are reasonable grounds for the objection. The decision of the appeals committee is **final** and no discussion will be entered into.

### Scratching

- No refund will be made for scratchings after nominations close unless accompanied by a vet or medical certificate within 7 days after the competition. The organising committee may retain 25% of entry fee for administration costs.

### Stewards

- Stewards will be required to ensure that the day progresses efficiently and on time. Each school is expected to provide **1 volunteer for every 2 riders**. Stewards will be expected to assist as gate and rail stewards for jumping. **NO STEWARD ... NO RIDE**

### Draw

- Please send a stamped self- addressed envelope for a copy of the draw **OR include your e-mail address on the entry form.**

### Stables

- Please note that stables must be cleaned after use.

### Camping Area

- Please also ensure that the grounds are left clean and tidy, with all rubbish removed.

### Wet Weather

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# PONY CLUB ASSOCIATION OF QUEENSLAND INC

## PARTICIPANT'S AGREEMENT

(Must be signed by all competitors who are not a member of an affiliated pony club)  
(For competitors under 18, a parent or guardian must sign.)

***WARNING: This is a legal document that affects your rights. If you do not understand it, consult a lawyer before signing it***

I agree to participate in this event on the following basis:

I acknowledge that competitive equestrian events involve the real risk injury, possibly serious. This includes injuries related to or resulting from pre-existing disabilities or medical conditions.

I understand that I should not participate in this event unless I have trained appropriately and my physical condition has been verified by a medical practitioner.

2. By participating, I accept all risks necessarily flowing from my participation which could result in loss of life, temporary or permanent injury. Accordingly, I release all people associated with the conduct of the event from, and will indemnify them (to the extent my actions are not excused or protected by law) against, all liability (*including* liability for their negligence) for all injury, loss or damage arising out of or connected with my participation in this event. For clarification, the people released include event organisers, promoters, sponsors, managers, the Pony Club Association of Queensland Inc, Buderim Pony Club, Matthew Flinders Anglican College and all of their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors and volunteers including event medical and paramedical personnel. This release and indemnity continues forever and binds my heirs, executors, personal representatives and assigns.

3. I consent to receiving any medical treatment that event organisers think desirable during or after the event.

4. I consent to event organisers using my name, image and likeness before, during or after the event, for event promotional, broadcasting or reporting purposes in any media.

5. I understand that any insurance cover effected for participants may not cover me for any or all injury, loss or damage sustained by me.

6. I acknowledge that safety precautions undertaken by the Organiser (such as course supervision, safety briefings, animal inspections and equipment safety checks) are a service to me and other competitors but are not a guarantee of safety.

7. Animals are ridden by me at my risk. The Organiser is not responsible for injury, loss or damage resulting from animal behaviour (including behaviour caused by the presence of other animals or participants). In particular, the Organiser is not responsible for animal selection on behalf of participants (for example, an animal may be unsuitable for a participant by reason of the participants inexperience or age).

8. My registration is not transferable to other people. If I am unable to compete, or if the event is cancelled, my registration fee is non-refundable.

9. I have listed below any medical or physical conditions from which I suffer that might affect my performance or be relevant if medical treatment is needed.

10. I agree to abide by all race rules and directions issued by the event organiser.

11. I certify that I am 18 years of age or older and I have read this document and fully understand it.
